




Installation Instructions

Ceramic Discs

- These instructions serve as a general guide only. Products must be installed by a licensed plumber, else the warranty is void.

- Flush the water supply pipes thoroughly to remove debris.

- Recommended Water Pressure - 500kPa

- Max Operating Pressure - 1200kPa


- Max Operation Temperature - 70° Celcius

- Installations must comply in accordance with Australian standards AS/NZS 3500

- All products are suitable for use with most instantaneous hot water services but not with gravity-fed water systems.

NOTE: In many states & territories the maximum operation pressure must not exceed 500kPa in accordance with AS/NZS 3500.1. If pressure exceeds 500kPa, pressure limiting valves must be installed by a licensed plumber.



(A) Wall Installation

Safety Note:

For your safety, Par Taps spindles are 'Contra Turn' designed. Handles should be fitted to turn/open towards the outlet thus preventing potential accidents such as scolding.

***NOTE: All Hob sets come complete and may only require handle alignment**

Tools Required;

- 2mm Allen Key
- 14mm Deep Tube Socket
- 25mm Deep Socket

1. Prior to installing ceramic disc assembly make sure seat surface is clean and smooth otherwise reseal and recheck. Also ensure that lines have been flushed.

2. Remove cartridge lock nut (3) from the Ceramic Disc Assembly (7A) as supplied. Ensure that the hot and cold indicators located on the bottom of the Ceramic Disc Assembly (7A) are placed in the corresponding side of the breach.

Note: Please refer to Fig 1 for rotation of Par Taps Ceramic Disc Assemblies.

3. Insert ceramic disc assembly (7A) into (A) wall breach or (B) tap body. Tighten ceramic disc assembly (7A) firmly using a 14mm Deep tube socket (not supplied).




Fig 7A: Ceramic Disc Assembly



4. Ensure that the disc is in the closed position and then fit handle to align.

*Fig 2: To align the handle loosen grub screw/s (2) from the extension (1) using 2mm allen key, then rotate the position of the extension (1) and ceramic disc cartridge (7) until the desired handle position is achieved.

5. Once aligned ensure the extension (1) is pushed firmly on to the ceramic disc (7) and tighten grub screw/s (2) firmly using the 2 mm allen key. Take care whilst doing this.

6. Place the fibre washer (4) over the ceramic disc assembly (7A) and onto the face or the (A) wall breach or (B) basin body.

7. Tighten the locking nut (3) over the ceramic disc assembly (7A) and tighten firmly using a 25mm deep tube socket. *For some product ranges such as Tudor hob, please use 24mm socket

8. Turn water supply on and check for leaks, then complete tapware assembly.

Warranty

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

Par Taps' warranty covers the repair and/or replacement of any product which is defective through faulty workmanship or faulty materials. Our warranty is in addition to other rights and remedies available to the customer under law.

The warranty period commences from date of purchase. In order to make a warranty claim you must follow the steps listed below. Your claim will then be considered and processed. Please note that you are responsible for the cost of returning the goods to Par Taps unless this involves unreasonable cost in which case Par Taps will make necessary arrangements for collection/inspection. Par Taps will decide the steps necessary to rectify the problem which may involve a repair, a replacement or a refund.

Par Taps will not be liable for any claim/s for labour, additional products or parts associated with alleged faulty product or for work not approved by Par Taps save for those covered by the Australian Consumer Law. Should a warranty claim be made and attended to by a Par Taps service agent and the fault is deemed to be due to an improper installation or due to other goods used in conjunction with the goods, Par Taps reserves the right to charge a call out fee and, if the service agent repairs the product, an additional service fee will be payable by the owner of the residence where the goods have been installed.

To the extent permitted by law, Par Taps will not be liable for any loss or damage to furniture, floor coverings, walls, fixtures or any other consequential loss of any kind caused by any defect in the products or components. Any warranty shall be void due to any of the following occurring:

- Products not installed by a licensed plumber.
- The inability to provide proof of purchase or documents with the adequate information.
- Tapware exposed to water pressures and or temperatures that exceed stated limitations as per the product
- Installation instructions.
- Isolation stop valves not fitted as stated on installation instructions
- Products not installed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation instructions
- Products used for incorrect applications, non-potable water etc.
- Damage as a result of debris/particles due to inadequate flushing of system prior to installation.
- Failure to clean and/or replace aerator insert.
- Damage to finishes by abrasive chemicals, sealants etc.
- Damage to finishes during installation or post installation
- Failure to observe manufacturer's care and cleaning instructions.

Commercial warranty is limited to a total of 1 year & is parts only.
